Mark your calendars for the 9th Annual LFBF YF&R/ LA Land Bank Youth Livestock Show to be held on April 29-30 benefiting the Louisiana AITC and the Louisiana Farm Bureau Foundations! Louisiana Farm Bureau's Ag in the Classroom and Scholarship Foundations are two of the most vital agricultural resources available to Louisiana's youth.

The LFBF YF&R's 9th Annual Youth Livestock Show will take place at the Lamar Dixon Expo Center, 9039 S St. Landry Ave, Gonzales, LA, 70737 on Friday and Saturday, April 29-30, 2022.
